## Public Notice

Alton Coal Development, LLC and Kane Mining, LLC plan to conduct blasting operations on the Coal Hollow Mine, located 3.9 miles south of Alton, Utah at the address 2010 South Alton Road.

As required under the mine and reclamation plan, ACT C/025/0005, the following information is published for general circulation.

Blasting operations and use of explosives at the Coal Hollow Mine will be conducted in accordance with the following:

MSHA Part 77 - Subpart N - Explosives and Blasting

Utah Administrative Code - R645-301-524

Coal Hollow Mine Specifications

Other Federal, State, and Local regulations governing the use of explosives.

Areas affected by blasting:

Mining areas within the NW/4, NE/4, Section 30, T39S, R5W, SLB&M and the SW/4, SE/4, Section 19, T39S, R5W, SLB&M.

Dates and Time periods:

Blasting can be conducted within any given week, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 1:00 PM and 4:00 PM.

Methods to control access:

Blasting signs and warning signs will be posted along the edge of any blasting area, outside the boundaries of the permit area. Guards will be posted to warn anyone that might come upon the site during blasting periods prior to any blasting taking place.

Type and patterns of audible warning and all-clear signals used before and after blasting:

Warning and all-clear signals of different character or pattern that are audible within a range of one-half mile from the point of the blast will be given. Each person within the permit area and each person who resides or works regularly within one-half mile of the blast site in the mine permit area will be notified of the meaning of the signals in the blasting schedule and notification. All guards at the entrances of the permit area will be knowledgeable of the proper signals so as to inform any one that might be present at their locations.

This notification is required under the Utah Administrative Code: R645-301-524.453 - 453 and must be published at least 10 days, but no more than 30 days, before beginning any blasting operations. This notice is for the next 12 months beginning August 15, 2011.
