Hi Kirk,

I have been speaking to Erik about planning out the trip and here is what we have decided so far:

Day 1 May 8:

We will take a look at the potential alluvial valley floor (AVF) areas that the BLM identified in the draft EIS. These areas are along the banks of Kanab Creek and most of which are outside the BLM coal lease blocks. Erik and I thought we could take a look at these locations on the first day without the other agency folks but maybe some of the private landowners may wish to be present.

Day 2 May 9:

We will spend the day with interagency personal from BLM and Division of Water Rights and any landowners wanting to be present. Here we will determine where any critical water rights may be located and target them protection and baseline sampling.
