

Dear Mr. Haddock,

Alton Coal Development, LLC is providing this submittal to make minor revisions to Diversion Ditch 1(DD1) and Pond 4. DD1 is located on the Eastern side of the property up gradient of mining activities and its purpose is to divert uncontaminated surface runoff from adjacent undisturbed areas around the mining. The previously permitted design brought this uncontaminated water into Sediment Impoundment 4. This submitted design allows the uncontaminated water to bypass pond 4 and with the addition of an engineered rock spreader discharges the water beyond the mining activity. Sediment Impoundment 4 has been revised to reflect the absence of an inlet from DD1 and to depict the addition of Rip Rap lining the outlet.


