This application will not pass the Initial Review of the engineering design, because Item #1 below has not been taken care of. Would you please submit revised figures 1 and 2 as previously requested? I will continue the IR review upon notification of their receipt.

Items requested after the Division's unofficial review on April 7 were as follows:

- 1) Extend beginning point of reconstruction north to the permit boundary in Figure 1 and Figure 2. Starting elevation of 6868' (from Figures 21, 21A in approved MRP). NOT DONE
- 2) Channel slopes will be seeded every year once final grade is established until vegetation cover is adequately established. DONE
- 3) Label Dan Guy's report with business name, contact and date. DONE
- 4) Delete the narrative about planting willows. They'd probably be difficult to establish and are not in the natural channel below the permit area. DONE

Following up on our conversation, here's the discussion points to add to the amendment prior to approval. Talk to Priscilla or Daron about the abatement deadline. It should probably be extended so I have time to approve the amendment in a findings report.

- 2) Channel slopes will be seeded every year once final grade is established until vegetation cover is adequately established.

- 4) Delete the narrative about planting willows. They'd probably be difficult to establish and are not in the natural channel below the permit area.
