An extension to July 21st to provide the Division with an amendment to the Coal Hollow MRP that provides the requisite narrative and design drawings for the sediment control measures installed on the south side of the excess spoil pile and the water line from the pit 10 sump to pond 3 is granted.

Based on our discussion regarding the need for documentation of sediment control measures in the permit, please also submit a narrative and design drawings for the sediment control measures that were installed in the gully that formed on the north side of the excess spoil pile.

Hello Steve,

Per our conversation today concerning the needs of the Division for plans for the gully at the base of the excess spoil pile and the water line from the pit 10 sump to pond 3, ACD would ask for an extension of 3 weeks or until July 21, 2015 to submit an amendment to the MRP. To address the gully, Appendix 5-7 of the MRP will be amended to show the location of the erosional feature and include details of actions taken to control it. The water line from Pit 10 sump to Pond 3 will require outside engineering, but it is expected that it can be completed within the 3 weeks.
