Kane County Road K3900 also known as the Alton Road or Sink Valley Road has been temporarily closed due to mining activity public access was detoured through a BLM permitted bypass road during the duration of the mining activities. This new routing is considered to be the only access around the mine location until the closed route is put back into use. This closure is permitted by the Utah Code and Statutes, 72-5-105.

I have been on the site visit today, March 30, 2016. I have reviewed the compaction results for the phase 1 existing of a portion of Kane County Road #K3993. After review I find that the compaction testing and method has been satisfactorily accomplished for Phase 1 release. This section of county road has satisfactorily passed compaction standards for sub grade of Kane County Road K3900.
