THE STATE OF UTAH TO ALL OPERATORS, TAKERS OF PRODUCTION, MINERAL AND LAND OWNERS, AND PARTICULARLY ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, SEVIER COUNTY, UTAH.

Notice is hereby given that tentative approval was given by the Utah Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining, to Southern Utah Fuel Company on July 22, 1977, to continue underground coal mining on portions of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 4 East, Sevier County, Utah. The name of the mine is the Convulsion Canyon Coal Mine, and the person representing the company in this matter is Mr. Verbal Anderson, Vice President, Southern Utah Fuel Company, P.O. Box 27, Salina, Utah 84454.

Southern Utah Fuel Company has fulfilled obligations under the Mined Land Reclamation Act of 1975 (Section 40-9, U.C.A. 1953 as amended), and will employ the following reclamation techniques on 16 acres of U.S. Forest Service Land:

- During Operations:
 - 1) Mining will be conducted in a safe and orderly manner.
 - 2) Surface drainage will be re-routed via adequate culverts beneath the surface facilities.
 - 3) Runoff from the pad surface will be clarified before being discharged.
 - 4) Dust from the haulage road will be minimized.

- After Operations:
 - 1) Extraneous debris, scrap, and structures will be removed from the site.
 - 2) All portals will be closed.
 - 3) The site will be regraded to naturally appearing slopes, scarified, and seeded.
 - 4) The haulage road will not be reclaimed to maintain access.

Reclamation performance surety will be established upon final approval of the reclamation plan.

Any person or agency aggrieved by this tentative decision is hereby requested to submit written protest within 30 days of August 5, 1977, to the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining, 1588 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah 84116, setting forth factual reasons for his complaint, and thereafter at a time and place heretofore determined, appear before the Board of Oil, Gas, and Mining, to show cause, if any there be, why this plan should not be approved.
