




The following points are added in response to the comments made by the U. S. Forest Service to the U. S. Geological Survey regarding Sufco's mining and reclamation plan - addendum number two.

1. Third paragraph, page 1 of addendum #2: Page 8 - Section 211.10C (3) i.

Add: "Yearly recreation use is light, but during deer and elk hunts, use is extremely heavy."

2. Second paragraph, page 2 of addendum #2: Page 13 - Section 211.10C (6) iii.

Add: "In order to provide adequate soil depth for vegetative establishment, soil will be at least three feet deep over any foundations that are buried in tact."

3. First paragraph on page 7 of addendum #2:

Add: "Seed variety and quantity specified by the Forest Service will be scattered and raked into all disturbed areas."

4. Second paragraph, page 3 of addendum #2: Page 14 & 15 - Section 211.10C (6) iv.

Delete: "The company does not intend to revegetate the surface of the road, however, after reclamation of the mine site, the road will be closed if required by the Forest Service."

Substitute: "It is not known at this time whether or not the continued use of this road will be needed by the Forest Service. If it is determined that this road should be eliminated, the road will be 'put to bed' by the company. Any bituminous surfacing will be broken up and disposed of in a manner prescribed by the Forest Service. The road bed will then be reclaimed and revegetated."

5. Third paragraph on page 3 of addendum #2:

Add: "Burial depth will be a minimum of three feet to assure proper soil depth for vegetation."

6. Third paragraph on page 4 of addendum #2: Page 19 - Section 211.401, item 1.

Delete: "In the near future, exposed mine rubbish will be removed."

Substitute: "All exposed mine rubbish will be removed by June 30, 1978."
