Sediment Trap

The Convulsion Canyon Coal Mine was inspected by Jim Smith and Mike Thompson on the 14th of June. The purpose of the visit was to inspect the sediment trap.

Mr. Thomas Gambill, Vice-President, Mining, Coastal States Energy Company, submitted a plan to modify the existing trap to conform with the intent of PL 95-87. Space does not permit a sediment pond of sufficient size to meet OSM's regulations.

It was found that the trap had not yet been modified. It was rather full of sediment and in need of cleaning. A letter will be sent to Mr. Gambill about the matter and hydroseeding the outslope of the pad will also be discussed.
