Dear Hank:

On March 25, 1980 Mr. Joseph C. Helfrich, Reclamation Officer for the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining contacted Mr. Kerry Frame of Southern Utah Fuel Company concerning Mining and Reclamation Plan Forms for the Levan Loadout Facility. Mr. Helfrich enclosed MR 1 and MR 2 Forms and indicated that these forms were required for compliance under the Permanent Regulatory Program. As you are aware, the Division is still operating under the Interim Regulatory Program and the Levan Loadout Facility is outside the scope of the present regulatory framework. It is possible that the Levan Loadout Facility may fall within the scope of regulation under the Permanent Program of the State of Utah. In such case, permit applications for the facility must be submitted to the Division within two months of the approval of the State Program by the Office of Surface Mining. Revised MR 1 & MR 2 Forms will be prepared by the Division to meet the more stringent standards under the Permanent Regulatory Program.
