A cursory inspection of the surface facilities of the above mentioned operation was conducted on March 7, 1980, by Gary Fritz from the Office of Surface Mining and Joe Helfrich from the Division. This operation is presently owned and operated by Southern Utah Fuel Company. State and Federal inspectors were acquainted with Ken Payne and Farrel Winn, construction engineers for the Levan Loadout Facility.

The area encompasses approximately 25 acres, containing one large excavated pond approximately (150'x200'x20') with an inlet culvert. There is no other means of runoff or sediment control on the permit area. Runoff is a problem in this area during periods of peak flow and should be addressed in a runoff and sediment control plan submitted to State and Federal regulatory authorities for compliance when the permanent regulatory program becomes effective.

No violations were issued as this facility does not fall under jurisdiction of the interim regulatory program.
