Dear Mr. Spencer

As we discussed on the telephone, a considerable amount of fill material was accumulated during the construction of the new mine fan, truck scales, and concrete sediment pond. This material and the remains of the old concrete sediment trap have been temporarily stored in the north end of our main mine yard. Because it is rather unsightly, we requested to embank and smooth this 4500 cubic yards of material on the face of the fill of the adjoining upper warehouse yard. We began this operation today because a contractor's bull dozer was available on a one time basis at minimum cost.

The enclosed map shows with contours the affect of this work. We request approval to leave the material in place permanently, rather than to remove it from the sight altogether.


