Enclosed for your review is a copy of a stability analysis on the road to the sedimentation pond. This analysis was submitted by Southern Utah Fuel Company as abatement to a violation issued by the Division. The report was deemed adequate to terminate the violation. Since the Division will be shortly reviewing SUFCO's Permanent Program Submittal, this information may be useful in that analysis. OSM technical staff apparently approved the road based on the Division's approval prior to the violation. The State approved the road under the stipulation that this stability plan would be submitted. The information was not submitted by SUFCO and finally a violation was issued.
