- STICK POSTAGE STAMPS TO ARTICLE TO COVER FIRST CLASS POSTAGE, CERTIFIED MAIL FEE, AND CHARGES FOR ANY SELECTED OPTIONAL SERVICES.** (see front)
1. If you want this receipt postmarked, stick the gummed stub on the left portion of the address side of the article, **leaving the receipt attached**, and present the article at a post office service window or hand it to your rural carrier. (no extra charge)

  4. If you want delivery restricted to the addressee, or to an authorized agent of the addressee, endorse **RESTRICTED DELIVERY** on the front of the article.
  5. Enter fees for the services requested in the appropriate spaces on the front of this receipt. If return receipt is requested, check the applicable blocks in Item 1 of Form 3811.
  6. Save this receipt and present it if you make inquiry.


This is to inform you that abatement work directed at topsoil protection is considered adequate. This letter terminates NOV 80-1-13-2, #2 of 2.

The ditch which has been installed is sufficient to protect the topsoil from water erosion. A silt fence was also required. In light of our discussion with Mr. Davis with regard to the placement of the fence, we will consider this matter pending.

As you know, the Class III road leading to the sediment pond requires further work to put it into compliance with UMC 817.171-175. Please see the enclosed memo for further details on this and other areas of concern.
