

RE: Meeting with SUFCO Officials

A meeting was held at the site of the Convulsion Canyon Mine in order to clarify operator concerns about the current ACR and to view the recent slump failure which occurred at the lower end of the parking lot. Those present at the meeting included Kerry Frame, Ken Payne, Keith Welch, John Garr, Wes Sorenson, and Mike Davies of SUFCO and Rick Summers and Dave Darby of the Division. A tour of the slump failure, proposed drainage of the transmitter pad, and the lower sediment pond discharge structures was followed by a discussion of alternatives and concerns about the undersized sediment pond design currently under review by the Division. The suggestion was made that use of the Universal Soil Loss Equation, flood-routing techniques, and/or an empirical relationship demonstrating the sediment settling capacity of the upper concrete basin may be an adequate demonstration for UMC 817.46. Rick Summers will contact SUFCO with related calculations post haste.
