A partial inspection was performed on May 11, 1983 by John Whitehead at the above noted minesite. He was accompanied by Mike Davis of SUFCO.

Due to extremely cold blizzard conditions, very little runoff was occurring at the minesite. Only two of the previous ten locations for sampling conductance were measured.

The sediment pond was discharging and a sample was split with Mr. Davis for analysis of TDS and TSS.

A question was raised as to the location of the pump for culinary water and leach field which serves the SUFCO mine. These two areas may fall into the category of support facilities requiring permit under that section of the regulations. This matter will be followed up during the next regular inspection.
