Dear Mr. Mortensen:

The Utah Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining has completed a review of the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) and amendments submitted by Southern Utah Fuel Company, for the Convulsion Canyon Mine. The regulatory authority has determined the plan to be apparently complete.

The Division will now prepare a Technical Analysis (TA) document to determine whether the proposed plan meets all the criteria of the Permanent Program Performance Standards according to the requirements of UCA, Section 40-10-1 et seq.

Per the attached letter, notice has been given to all appropriate agencies having jurisdiction over or an interest in the area of the proposed operations that a complete plan is available for public review.

Upon receipt of this letter, Southern Utah Fuel Company must publish an advertisement in a local newspaper within the general area of the proposed operation providing all information as required under UMC 786.11(a), with a copy of the notice sent to the Division.


Provided no public protests are initiated within the allotted time frames, pursuant to UMC 786.12(b), the Division will continue to proceed with the permit approval process.

Once a plan has been determined complete, and provided there are no protests, conferences or hearing requests, the Division has a maximum of 120 days to issue a final approval or denial of the permit application pursuant to UMC 786.23(b) (2) (ii).
