The Division has reviewed Southern Utah Fuel Company's (SUFCO) plans to install a new sanitary drainfield near Quitchupah Creek. Approval may be granted when the following conditions requiring commitments and the submittal of additional information have been satisfied.


1. State Health must approve the plans for the drainfield and percolation tests must meet minimum criteria.
2. No disturbance may occur within 75 feet of the stream bed.
3. Topsoil must be stripped from the new road and drainfield areas and any borrow areas and either stockpiled or used to reclaim previously disturbed areas.
4. Reclamation seed mixes for the old drainfield, new drainfield and any borrow areas used must be submitted. Any permanent revegetation practices must comply with the requirements of UMC 817.111-.117.
5. If borrow areas are used, they must be indicated on a map. The volume of borrowed material must be reported in cubic yards, along with the amount of surface disturbance that will need to be reclaimed in these areas.

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Upon commitment to conditions 1 and 2 and the submittal of additional information to answer conditions 3 through 5, the Division will review the response for compliance with the appropriate regulations and determine whether or not approval for the modification can be granted.
