Enclosed for your review is a copy of a revised vegetation study and revegetation plan recently submitted to this office by Southern Utah Fuel Company (SUFCO).

As you will recall, the Memo of Understanding between our Divisions calls for Division of Wildlife Resources (DWR) to respond to Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (DOGM) regarding adequacy of a submitted plan to ameliorate or mitigate impacts of the proposed operation on wildlife resources, within 60 days of receipt of this plan.
