Dear Susan:

Thank you for making arrangements for the meeting we attended in your office yesterday. Wess and I felt real good about the results and we appreciate your efforts.

We have already begun the work requested in your February 1, 1984 letter. Now that we have consensus between the agencies involved regarding the direction we should take on final reclamation, we will proceed toward development of a consolidated reclamation plan with emphasis as follows:


The final regrading will produce a reconstructed stream channel through the center of the minesite. Side slopes will be gently graded down to this channel. The channel will be graded to have multiple concave gradient segments in series. The consolidated plan will include disturbed area run-off calculations. We will also present the calculations for channel rip rap sizing and specify rip rap material durability specifications. The sediment pond will be retained if regrading material balance considerations permit. In any event, sediment control will be achieved with matting of jute, burlap, paper, or some other erosion control material held in place over a fertilized and seeded surface. Straw bales or silt fence material will provide the final sediment barrier to the stream channel. Some side slope drainages may require rip rap also for which, pertinent calculations with other information will be provided in the plan. There will be commitments to maintain sediment control matting and to monitor water quality on a routine basis at the site until bond release.

We expect that development of this final reclamation plan will take about one month. We will make every effort to have it submitted to you before the end of March.
