A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector was accompanied by Mike Davis of Southern Utah Fuel Company. The visit took place on October 24, 1984.

The purpose of the inspection was to familiarize the inspector with the mine site during the recent transfer of inspector responsibilities. SUFCO is now involved with building a retaining wall behind the office and below the substation. Due to recent subsidence the slope became unstable and is being reenforced. This has all been documented under the previous inspections.

All divirsions and sediment facilities were viewed with no problems evident.

The sediment pond was discharging but the quality looked good. SUFCO may need to decant this pond before winter as the level is fairly high. Water samples will be taken during future inspections to compare water quality with company records.
