A partial inspection of the above mentioned mine site was conducted on May 16, 1985 by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector was accompanied by Wes Sorenson of Southern Utah Fuel Company.

During this inspection the inspector toured the substation facility. Due to UP&L's new requirements the operator must move the southeast corner of the fence back to allow for the prerequisite buffer zone. The inspector informed the operator that since additional area will be disturbed (although relatively minor) an approval from the Division would be required and should be in hand before any work is initiated.

A walk to the water tank revealed good revegetation on this site. A diversified variety of species has been established here.

The mine yard was toured and no problems noted.

The plans for the fan drainage are due May 25, 1985 as agreed on April 25, 1985 by the operator. These plans are to address corrective measures to ensure hydrologic compliance at the undisturbed drain by the fan. The present approved configuration was deemed inadequate due to current unsatisfactory sampling results.
