A partial inspection was conducted at the above-mentioned mine site on September 11, 1985, by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector was accompanied by Mike Davis of Southern Utah Fuel Company and Henry Austin from the Office of Surface Mining.

The work to expand the fencing at the substation is not finished yet. This work is the result of new requirements by the power company for grounding clearance, forcing the company to move the fence back. The extra fencing is complete, but the grade at the lower end still needs to be raised a foot or so. The associated drop drain for runoff also needs to be raised (the frames are in, but the concrete has yet to be poured).

The abatement for NOV N85-6-7-1 was viewed by the fan housing. The area is now completely isolated from the undisturbed drainage, and the diversions are complete to isolate the disturbed runoff. The sump is in place and, although the area was relatively dry, it should be operational. The work was adequate to terminate the violation.

All channels and diversions were clear during this inspection. The company is preparing to decant their sediment pond in the near future. They are aware of their obligations in this area.
