A partial inspection was conducted at the above-mentioned mine site on October 9, 1985, by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector was accompanied by Mike Davis of Southern Utah Fuel Company.

Prior to the inspection, there had been six to seven inches of snowfall; but most had melted by the time of the visit. The ground was still very wet, and a steady drizzle persisted throughout the inspection. Six-tenths of an inch of moisture had been measured in the last 24 hours.

The sediment pond was discharging at this time. Samples were taken by both the operator and the inspector and submitted for analysis.

The work on the substation is now finished, and the drop drain is in. Old equipment is being stored on site and will be removed shortly.

The newly reconstructed fan site was fully operational, although it was dry. No water was noted from the fan housing at this time.

At this time, SUFCO is in the process of installing their long wall. They are hoping to have it all in and ready for the appropriate inspection by October 17, 1985.
