We acknowledge the Division's and the Fish and Wildlife Service's concerns for potential damage to the escarpment that will be undermined by modifying the subsidence zone. Southern Utah Fuel Company believes the mining activity will not adversely affect the escarpment and agrees to accept the conditions set forth in your November 3, 1986 letter. Specifically, we will conduct a raptor survey and provide a high level of subsidence monitoring as detailed in the conditions.

We understand that the conditional approval to modify the subsidence zone will be for the longwall panels extending beyond the west escarpment of Quitcupah Canyon as shown on the revised Subsidence Zone Map 80-10B.
