Thank you for allowing us the opportunity to review Southern Utah Fuel Company's response document for waste rock disposal in Sevier County, Utah. As all proposed disturbance would occur on private lands, we have no comments relating directly to the proposal.

After reviewing the response document, however, we would again like to call to your attention the discrepancy concerning the ownership of the coal resource within the subject tract of land. In our letter of September 11, 1987 to your office, we noted that the coal resource in the subject tract is owned by the Federal Government. In specific, no mention of this is made in the Warranty Deed (Exhibit 1), the Property Ownership Map (Map 1), or in the document. Even though the coal resource is owned by the Federal Government, no adverse affect to potential coal development is expected.
