Dear Mr. Morris:

The elevation of the new ventilation portal, Quitchupah Canyon for Southern Utah Fuel Company, was chosen to balance cut and fill quantities. The elevation of the pad can be raised slightly if excess cut material is available. Since excess cut material, if such exists when the pad is constructed, would be noncombustible it could also be stockpiled within the mine or removed to SUFCo's waste rock disposal site. In no case will excess cut material be wasted or stockpiled within the 100-year flood plain of Quitchupah Creek.
