Enclosed is a minor modification for Southern Utah Fuel Company's MRP. The modification consists of redesignating the upper pad area south of the shop building from a storage area to a coal storage area. This area is within the boundary of the disturbed area with all drainage reporting to the sediment pond.


The coal storage area will be for a 10,000 ton run-of-mine stockpile. The stockpile will be of the conical lowering well design with a 265 feet covered stacker belt from the existing tipple building to the proposed lowering well. Reclaim of the coal will be from within a concrete reclaim tunnel via two vibratory feeders and a 290 feet covered reclaim belt to the top of the existing tipple building. The existing pad will be extended to the east approximately 20 feet by cutting back the slope and installing a retaining wall. The pad will be extended 30-40 feet to the west by relocating the existing road and installing a bin wall. Fourteen copies of MRP update materials are included for Division distribution. The updates have been formulated for insertion into the existing MRP in Volume 3.

The construction dates are tentatively set to start site work, relocation of the existing roadway, construction of a bin wall and installing a concrete retaining wall against the cut slope this fall after Division approval. The remainder of the system will be constructed in the Spring of 1989. Due to the time frames involved with Division of Air Quality approval, Southern Utah Fuel Company requests conditional approval to start construction on the system as soon as possible. As per our meeting with Ken May, Randy Harden and Lynn Kunzler on September 8, 1988, this approval will allow 1988 construction before adverse weather prevents outside construction. ✓

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This letter will serve as a formal request of approval for the above minor modification to Southern Utah Fuel Company's MRP. It was our understanding from the meeting that this will not require an increase in bonding of our present five year permit.
