RE: Stipulation Response Approval, Waste Rock Disposal Site, Southern Utah Fuel Company, Convulsion Canyon Mine, ACT/041/002, Sevier County, Utah

## Summary

The Convulsion Canyon Mine Waste Rock Disposal Site Permit Stipulation Response, received September 26, 1988, has been reviewed. Stipulations UMC 817.22(1) - JSL, UMC 817.48-(1) - JSL, and UMC 81.99-(1) - JSL are considered to be adequately addressed.

## Discussion

### UMC 817.22-(1) - JSL

The operator has committed to remove 45" of soil where available and redistribute 30" of soil over the waste material. The requirements of this stipulation is addressed in section 3.2.3, 4.5 and in Appendix III.

### UMC 817.48-(1) - JSL

The operator has committed to submit a disposal plan within thirty days of receipt of analysis to the Division if the quarterly waste analysis indicates that an acid- or toxic-forming potential exist other than high boron levels. The operator has further committed to bury all acid- or toxic-forming materials within thirty days after the material is first exposed. The requirements of this stipulation is addressed in section 3.1.5.

### UMC 817.99-(1) - JSL

The requirements of this stipulation is addressed in section 3.1.4. The operator has committed to notify the Division in the event of a slide or other damage as required by this regulation.
