Summary:

SUFECO's proposal to provide additional coal storage capacity to the mine site is within the currently disturbed area. The operator has outlined the area in which the project is to be located and has submitted a revised cost estimate for the additional facilities. It is recommended that this modification be approved.

Analysis:

Additional costs for the facilities is estimated at \$66,410 to demolish and remove the run-of-mine stockpile addition. Currently, Sufco's bond was determined to be \$1,172,000. This addition represents a change in the bond amount of less than 6%. Rather than adjustment of the current bond amount, the amount shall be adjusted at such time when revisions to the facilities exceed 10% of the bond amount, or, during the next permit review period.

The operator is considered to have submitted sufficient information to consider the proposal complete. No stipulations are recommended.
