

Re: Abatement of Items Addressed Under Ten-Day Notice (TDN)  
88-02-006-001, TV2, Southern Utah Fuel Company, Convulsion  
Canyon Mine, ACT/041/002, Folder #2 and #5, Sevier County,  
Utah

Pursuant to the Office of Surface Mining oversight inspection conducted on January 27 and 28, 1988, the OSM inspector made it apparent that two items must be amended in your Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP). The first of these concerns language in Volume Number 8, under section UMC 817.23 Topsoil Storage, of the MRP. This section describes the operation as having no topsoil storage at the mine site. This must be changed to reflect the current topsoil storage and stockpile protection status at your site. The correct information should be submitted to the Division by March 31, 1988 as a replacement page (pages) to the existing text. Please submit fourteen copies for proper distribution.

The second issue concerns permit condition USFS Number 3. Information regarding this condition, as you know, must be submitted by March 1, 1988.
