Re: Determination of Completeness, Waste Rock Disposal Site,
Convulsion Canyon Mine, ACT/041/002, Folder No. 2, Sevier
County, Utah

The Division has reviewed the information received March 31, 1988, in response to the Determination of Completeness Reviews of February 2 and March 10, 1988, for the proposed Waste Rock Disposal Site. This information has been found to be adequate to determine the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) apparently complete. There was an apparent misunderstanding regarding the Division's request for more information about boron in the coal waste material. This can be rectified in the response to the Division's Technical Deficiency Review, sent to you on March 30, 1988. A technical review memo is attached to this letter for clarification.

At this time the applicant should publish a Notice of Complete Permit Application as required by UMC 786.11(a) and discussed in the Division's March 10 letter. A copy of the publication notice should be sent to the Division as soon as it is available. The Division will notify all other interested agencies and allow for their comment prior to making a final decision to approve or disapprove the application.
