IN THE MATTER OF PROPOSED COAL MINING ACTIVITIES WITHIN 100 FEET OF A PUBLIC ROAD AT SOUTHERN UTAH FUEL COMPANY'S (SUFCO'S) PROPOSED WASTE ROCK DISPOSAL SITE.

THE STATE OF UTAH TO ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN THE PROPOSED COAL MINING ACTIVITIES WITHIN 100 FEET OF A PUBLIC ROAD AT SUFCO'S PROPOSED WASTE ROCK DISPOSAL SITE LOCATED IN SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, SEVIER COUNTY, UTAH.

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Section 40-10-24(4)(C), Utah Code Annotated, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, State of Utah, will provide an opportunity for a public hearing regarding the possible coal mining activities within 100 feet of the county road going from I-70, Exit 72, to the SUFCO mine site.



If no request for a public hearing is received by the aforementioned date, the hearing will not be held.

If written request is received, a hearing will be held on Thursday, May 26, 1988, at 1:30 p.m., in the basement of the Salina City Hall.

If scheduled, the purpose of the proceeding will be to receive public comment which would show cause as to why the Division should not find that the proposed Mining and Reclamation Plan at the Waste Rock Disposal Site will protect the interests of the public and landowners affected by the impacts of the proposed coal mining activities within 100 feet of the county road going from I-70, Exit 72, to the SUFCO mine site, Sevier County, Utah.
