(b) The operator must provide a vegetation map of the Quitchupah lease area.

UMC 817.97 Protection of Fish, Wildlife and Related
Environmental Values-(BAS)

(d)(4) The operator must commit to: (1) adequate sizing of pillars to prevent subsidence; (2) repair of subsidence damage which negatively affects land uses; (3) an inventory of raptor nests along escarpments, prior to undermining; and (4) procurement of necessary state and federal permits for raptor nests, threatened by subsidence.
