Re: Partial Approval, New Subsoil Storage Area, Southern Utah Fuel Company, Convulsion Canyon Mine, ACT/041/002-89A, Folder #2, Sevier County, Utah

The Division has reviewed the analysis of material proposed to be placed at the Waste Rock Disposal Site, received May 3, 1989. The material is not toxic and is suitable to be used as fill material in final reclamation of the Convulsion Canyon Mine. It is not suitable to be used as a substitute topsoil material due to a high EC value.

Approval is hereby given to place the material in the designated storage area as shown in your April 27, 1989 submittal. Topsoil should be removed prior to placing the subsoil material, and stored in a separate pile. Both piles should be bermed and sediment controls placed and identification signs posted, as soon as they are completed. The Division will notify you by separate letter of information required to be incorporated into the Mining and Reclamation Plan regarding this material.
