In accordance with the conditions of NPDES Discharge Permit UT-0022918, Part II-I-3 and Utah Coal Mining Rules R645-301-731.223, Southern Utah Fuel Company is herewith providing the written notification of a failure to comply with the maximum effluent limitations for TDS at outfall 003.

The monthly average for TDS concentration of 845 mg/l exceeds the 800 mg/l limitation established in the current NPDES discharge permit. The March 2, 1992 sample had a TDS value of 864 while the March 18, 1992 sample had a TDS value of 825. The March 18, 1992 laboratory report was received on April 2, 1992.
