**SUMMARY:**

The proposed submittal was received in the PFO on March 12, 1998. The changes include a new air quality approval order; this was necessary due to the fuel conversion of the furnace in the truck scale building from diesel to propane. This change is reflected in page 4-14 (Chapter 4). A change of heading on the remaining Chapter 4 pages to reflect Canyon Fuel Company, LLC ownership is the only other change. No changes have been made to any text of Chapter 4. Division Order 92A brought this document up to it's current standard.

**TECHNICAL ANALYSIS:**

**R645-301-420      Air Quality**

Analysis:

As indicated above, the only change to the air quality approval order is with regard to DAQE-154-98, which is the approval order for the mine site. This was necessary due to the fuel conversion of the truck scale house furnace. DAQE-154-98 was approved by the Utah Division of Air Quality on February 27, 1998.

No changes have been made to BAQE-126-88 (approval order for the waste rock disposal site).
