

Lacking in the first submittal were adequate water monitoring data and the 5-year mining projection map for the Pines tract. Therefore, these items are being submitted under the cover of this letter and attached C1 and C2 forms. Please note that the water monitoring data has been included as Appendix 7-18, the PHC for the entire Pines Tract. This entire PHC is being submitted at this time to avoid duplication of effort as SUFCO prepares to submit a significant revision to the existing M&RP to include the Pines Tract lease area.




Canyon Fuel Company, LLC was the successful bidder on the Pines Tract UTU-76195. To provide efficient recovery and orderly development of these reserves Canyon needs to begin development access into the Pines Tract in December 1999. If this development cannot be started then, it will be impossible to develop the first planned longwall panel in sufficient time to avoid interruption to operations following completion of the 14L4E longwall panel in the present longwall block. Mining operations will have to be curtailed or the first panel development will be cut short and longwall reserves bypassed. In any case maximum economic recovery of these reserves could best be implemented by allowing development to proceed into the Pines Tract while a complete mine plan is being approved.


This submittal includes a new map showing the ROW application, modifications to the text in Chapter 1 on pages 1-33, 1-35 to 1-37, and a copy of the application sent to BLM for the underground development access.

Approval to mine the ROW would involve no environmental impact since only first mining would be done at a depth of about 1,000 ft. The EIS process has been completed for the Pines Tract Project and was issued in January 1999.

Your timely review and approval of the ROW on the 160-acre lease modification request as an incidental boundary change will be greatly appreciated. Approval is respectfully requested by August 1, 1999. This action will allow continued operations of all mining sections at the SUFCO Mine and recovery of the reserves in the lease modification area.
