Dear Mr. Dykman:

The Division has received a proposal from Canyon Fuel Company to build a substation on Forest Service land in Link Canyon near the town of Emery. The disturbed area would be about 0.12 acres. Part of the substation would be on land previously disturbed for the Link Canyon Mine.

In 1996, the Utah Abandoned Mines program was considering reclamation of this site and contracted Everett Bassett to perform an archaeological survey of the area. He determined, and SHPO concurred, this mine is not eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. No other sites were found in this area.
