In June of 1997, the Manti-La Sal National Forest issued your firm a special use permit to conduct archaeological data recovery at the Crazy Bird Rockshelter Site (42Sv896) and testing at other sites in the SUFCO Mine area. Terms of the permit required a final report to be submitted to the Forest for review 24 months after the completion of fieldwork; transfer of the excavated materials to the College of Eastern Utah Prehistoric Museum was to immediately follow. Fieldwork was completed by AERC in September of 1997. Thus, under original plans stipulated in your permit, a final report was due in the fall of 1999. During the fall-winter of 1999 in conversations between yourself and Forest archaeologist Stan McDonald, AERC requested an extension of time to complete the final report. The Forest agreed to extend the deadline with the understanding that a draft of the final report would be submitted no later than February 1, 2000.

Since granting this extension, the Forest has received no correspondence from AERC regarding the status of AERC's progress towards completion of the final report. Consequently, we request that AERC promptly provide the Forest with a progress report on the status of final report preparations and plans to transfer the excavated collections to the CEU Prehistoric Museum as stipulated in your special use permit. We also request a draft of the final report be received no later than September 15, 2000 for review and subsequent revision.
