

INTRODUCTION

Proposed amendment to SUFCO Mine was received on September 27, 2000 by the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining in Salt Lake City.

An approval was given to the permittee by the Division for the construction of the substation at Link Canyon. The permittee has installed a substation at Link Canyon for the transferring of electrical power from the surface to the underground working for the mining of coal. The sub-station is located within the disturbed area of the permitted area. The amendment is an As-built drawing showing a three hundredths of an acre larger design than the original design. The total disturbed area calculations have been updated to reflect this change.

The information found in the proposal is considered adequate to meet requirements of the Division.

SUPPORT FACILITIES AND UTILITY INSTALLATIONS

Regulatory Reference: 30 CFR Sec. 784.30, 817.180, 817.181; R645-301-526.

Analysis:

The permittee has submitted an As-built drawing of the sub-station located at Link Canyon. The disturbed area has increased three hundredths of an acre from the existing design.

The As-built also includes a P.E. certified Plate 5-2E a map which is showing a cross-section giving the cut and fill of the sub-station area.

Findings:

The requirements of this section of the regulations are considered adequate in regard to the proposed permit change.

This amendment is considered adequate to meet the requirements of this section of the R645 Coal Rules.
