 Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:

As required as part of the Sufco Fourth Quarter Water Monitoring reporting requirements, I have included a map illustrating the locations of points FP-1 and FP-2. The point labeled as FLOW 1 illustrates the location of the beginning of perennial flow on 10-4-01 in the Main Fork of Box Canyon for FP-1. No perennial flow was noted in the East Fork of the East Fork of Box Canyon this year on 10-4-2001 for FP-2. The point labeled as FLOW 2 on the attached map illustrates the location of the flow discharging from the spring Pines 105. It does not represent perennial flow in the East Fork of the East Fork but rather the short distance that water flowed below Pines 105.

The electronic data for the Fourth Quarter 2001 water monitoring at Sufco has already been uploaded to the Division's EDI site. Continuous flow data for sites Pines 407 and 408 has been e-mailed to you in an Excel format.


