The Link Canyon amendment is the only permitting action under review by the Division. This amendment is scheduled to be reviewed by the Division by October 4, 2002.

4A. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: DIVERSIONS

The diversions were spot-checked and complied with the performance standards. No water was flowing within these diversions.

4D. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: WATER MONITORING

The second quarter water monitoring was submitted into the EDI system. The permittee has completed water sampling for the third quarter. The samples are at the lab for analysis.

7. COAL MINE WASTE/REFUSE PILES/IMPOUNDMENTS

The refuse pile was inspected and has been graded. No hazardous conditions were noticed during the inspection.

8. NONCOAL WASTE

The area was generally clear of non-coal waste material.

No new support facilities were constructed since the last inspection.
