Point well taken. We are a little out in front of our headlights on this one.

However, the Forest has also issued a Road Use permit authorizing commercial use of a Forest Service Road independent of the DOGM authorized activities. SUFCO has advised us of their intent to begin mobilization for this project on Friday of this week, necessitating a prework meeting prior to that date to ensure understanding of our permit requirements. I would hope that all prework concerns could be addresses in a single on-the-ground meeting but if Pete is not available to participate in the meeting presently arranged, he will need to schedule a separate meeting to discuss items authorized by the Division.

I'll commit the Forest folks to doing a better job at this coordinating thing.

Thank you for arranging this meeting. It is always helpful to get together before the construction happens, so that everyone has a good understanding of what is to take place. However, in keeping with our "roles and responsibilities" outline, I feel obligated to point out that this meeting should be under the purview of DOGM. It is important that we funnel operational requirments through one agency so that we don't have an operator torn between serving two or three masters. Certainly, in this case the BLM and the Forest Service are welcome to participate and provide input to the process, but that input should be given to DOGM first and then DOGM should be the one dealing with the operator. For the Link Canyon project, Pete Hess is the DOGM representative and we would appreciate it if you would work through him in dealing with the operator. Thanks again, and please let me know if there is anything else I can do to help with this project.
