When Steve Fluke and I went down to look at the abandoned equipment issue, we also went out to the gates in Link Canyon. The old Mine is not making any ground water, and Mike Davis was concerned that they cannot meet the requirements of the approved plan, as far as providing water for the riparian area. When I got back to PFO, I called Tom Lloyd and left a message indicating that we had a problem as there is no ground water to maintain the willows. I think I mentioned to Mike davis that they need to submit an amendment relative to this problem. Tom Lloyd has never called me back concerning the issue. It looks like SUFCO may have to permit a UPDES discharge point, but then again, isn't there some kind of Forest Service stipulation that Mine water cannot be discharged on the Forest ?? That seems to have popped into my head.....that's all I can tell you at this point.
