The Division is very interested in the ongoing evaluation of the effects of mining in the East Fork of Box Canyon. Representatives of various agencies have visited this site and have identified subsidence features that may be affecting this area. This letter is a reminder for Canyon Fuel Company, LLC to move forward with the commitment in your approved mining and reclamation plan to monitor and evaluate the stream and remediate the effects of mining. A stream alteration permit will be required for any work in the stream. We anticipate working with you and the other agencies involved in this project very closely to accomplish any repair work that may need to be done in this area. You should also recall that your monitoring and mitigation plan calls for you to submit a hydrologic and subsidence summary report within 90 days after subsidence monitoring is completed. Please keep us informed.
