Dear Mr. May:

The Division has completed a review of the information you submitted on August 30, 2010 revising the SUFCO Mine plan to include the addition of the west coal leases. This application is considered to be administratively complete. A technical review of your plan has been initiated. Technical deficiencies, if any, will be forwarded to you as reviews are completed. The Division will also coordinate with other agencies and incorporate their comments into our review process. Issues raised will need to be resolved prior to approval of permit revision.

At this time you should publish a Notice of Significant Permit Revision for changing the SUFCO mine plan to include the west coal leases as required by R645-300-121. A copy of the publication should be sent to the Division as soon as it is available. You should also insure that a copy of the application is on file at the Sevier County Courthouse. The Division will complete a technical review, which must find that your application is technically complete. We look forward to working with you throughout the permitting process. Please call if you have any questions.
