Hi Leland and Chris,

I have been getting a lot of calls and letters from Leon Christensen, one of the property owners of a cabin in the Acord Lakes area. He is concerned about a couple of springs near Acord Lakes and whether or not there may be any possible effects that could impact the subdivision his cabin is located in.

When I look at the map, the springs he's talking about are located close to Acord Lakes, which puts them outside of the newly-drawn CHIA area boundary that incorporates the expansion of the West Lease. But when he was talking to me on the phone, he is making it sound like the springs are directly in-line with where you will be mining. I'd like to verify the location of these springs - my feeling is they are outside of the CHIA, but want to be sure. I'm thinking that if they are more in-line with where the mining will occur, then we may want to incorporate them into the SUFCO monitoring plan. He's also talked with Marc Stilson and has indicated that Marc wants to take a look at these springs as well.

It is your decision with how involved you would like to be with this gentlemen's concerns, but if you do want to be represented, just let me know and we can put this field visit on our calendars for sometime in late spring. Feel free to call me if you would like to discuss further.
