
Dear Mr. Davis:

I am writing to you at this time in regard to the South Fork Quitcupah 2R2S Amendment Project. A permitting error by Canyon Environmental resulted in a delayed submission of the cultural resources report. It was submitted to the Utah State Historic Preservation Office (USHPO) in May 2012. We have received concurrence from the USHPO that there will be an adverse impact on site 42SV3464, a small rock shelter.

Concurrently, we are consulting with the Navajo, Ute, Paiute, and Hopi tribes for comments or concerns. When we have received their comments, we will construct a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) which will guide the mitigation of the rock shelter through excavation. The U.S. Forest Service, Utah State Historic Preservation Officer, and Canyon Fuel Company, L.L.C. will be signatories of this document.
