We appreciate your timely development of the salinity offset program and associated documents completed on December 1, 2014, as required by the compliance schedule.

As you are aware, the Total Dissolved Solids effluent limit concentration of 1,289 mg/L for Outfall 002, as specified in Part I.D.3.a of the permit, became effective on December 1, 2014.
